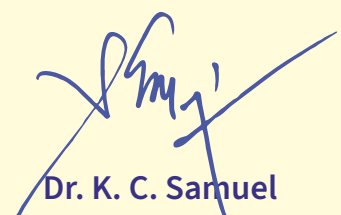

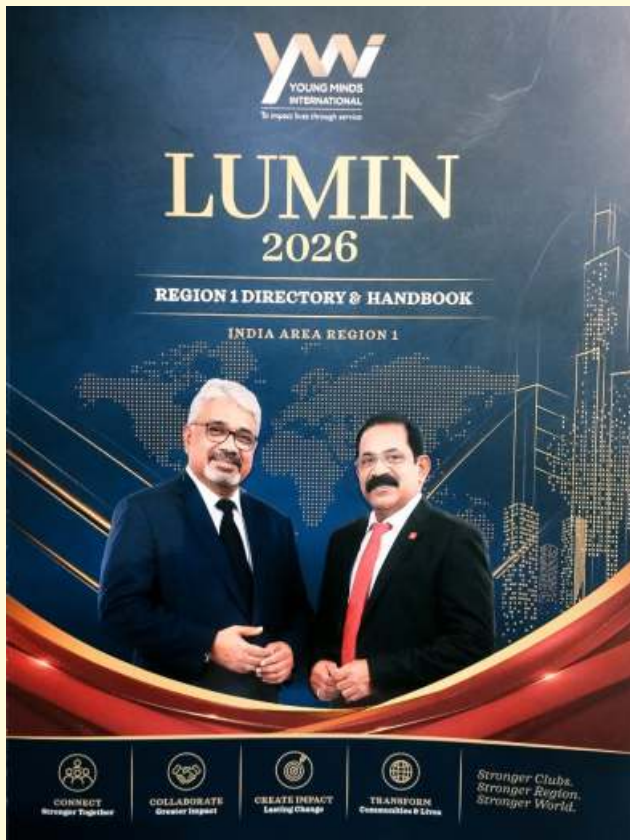

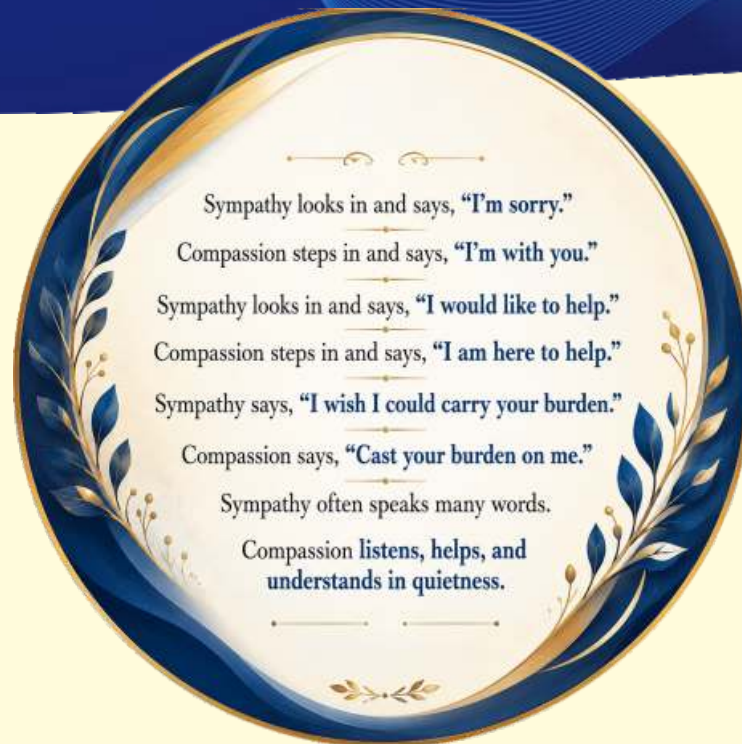

THE POWER OF COMPASSION



There is an important difference between sympathy and compassion—one that demonstrates the life-changing impact compassion can have on another person's life.

One day, a young man named Mark was walking home from school when he noticed a boy ahead of him trip and drop everything he was carrying: books, two sweaters, a baseball bat, a glove, and a small tape recorder.

Mark knelt down and helped the boy gather his belongings. Since they were heading in the same direction, he offered to carry some of the load. As they walked, Mark learned that the boy's name was Bill. Bill loved video games, baseball, and history, but he was struggling with several of his other subjects.

When they reached Bill's home, Bill invited Mark in for a Coke and to watch television. The afternoon passed pleasantly with laughter and conversation before Mark headed home.

Over the next few years, they continued to see each other at school. They occasionally had lunch together, graduated from junior high, and eventually attended the same high school. Although they only crossed paths from time to time, their friendship endured.

Three weeks before graduation, Bill asked Mark if they could talk.

Bill reminded Mark of the day they had first met.

"Did you ever wonder why I was carrying so many things home that day?" Bill asked.

"You see, I had cleaned out my locker because I didn't want to leave a mess for anyone else. I had also taken some of my mother's sleeping pills and was on my way home to commit suicide."

Bill continued, "After spending time talking and laughing with you that afternoon, I realized I didn't want to die. I would have missed that time with you and so many other wonderful moments that followed. Mark, I'm trying to tell you that when you stopped to help me pick up my books, you did much more than that—you saved my life."

Compassion is a quality that exists in every person. Yet, it is also a quality that can easily be overlooked or forgotten. While it is innate, it can also be nurtured, strengthened, and developed through practice.

Compassion involves two essential elements: intention and action. Intention is the willingness to open our hearts to others. Action is what we choose to do in response.

We never truly know how our words or actions may affect the people we encounter. Mark's simple act of compassion saved a life. We, too, may touch someone's life in ways we never fully realize by showing kindness, offering encouragement, or simply being present for our family, friends, and the people we meet each day.

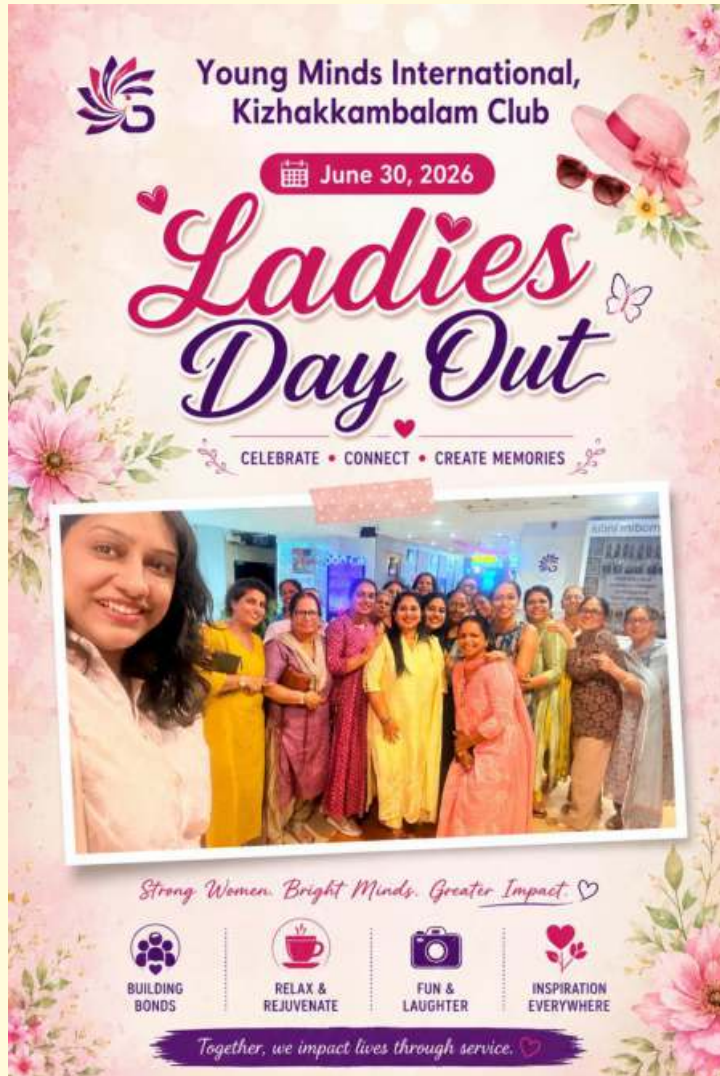
