


# Building Homes and Hope

At the same time, we have people around us who are living together with strangers in orphanages. Some do not know their blood relatives, while a few left their homes due to lack of any supporting family members.

One such home at Chennimalai namely Bharathiar Kulanthaigal Kappagam is being operated by few good hearts. Around 25 children of varying age groups and 15 senior citizens are being taken care of in this home.

YMI ERODE had interacted with the person in charge and as per their request provided free rice, groceries and cooking oil that will meet their needs for about three weeks.

It really touched our hearts when we spent a few minutes talking with each of them. We couldn't bear the statement of one senior person who told us that he had offered his body to the government hospital after his lifetime, as it was the only thing he could do that will help someone in their medical studies. He even showed us the card, saying that it's always in his pocket.

This is our second project and we returned back with some satisfaction but with a heaviness in our hearts.

**Single Breasted Single Button Suit**

Very easy to remember:  
When standing you must  
button the only button.  
When sitting, you must unbutton.



**Single Breasted Two Button Suit**

The top button must be fastened when standing and the second button should never be fastened.  
Jacket must be unbuttoned when seated.



**Single Breasted Three Button Suit**

There are two options.  
When standing, fasten top two buttons and leave the third unfastened or fasten only the middle button.

Some of the meetings we attend are sweet and memorable. We often think as to what makes a meeting elegant and enjoyable. There are several factors:-
